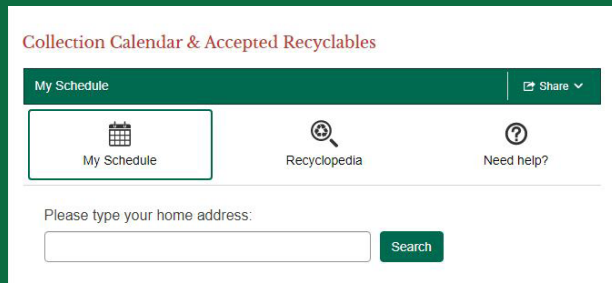

Did you know?

You should not crush your recyclables!



Leaving cans, bottles, and jugs intact allows for optimal sorting at the processing facility. Crushing or flattening these items may cause the sorting machinery to mistakenly identify these items as paper.

Not all plastics can be recycled!



Plastics are classified into 7 categories, based on their Resin Identification Codes.



Due to the market demand, James City County only accepts number 1 and 2 plastic bottles and jugs with a neck.

Why Recycling is Important

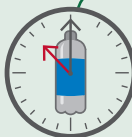
Recycling not only offers a way to divert waste from the limited space used for landfills, but also creates 7-10 times more jobs than landfills.

► More Reasons to Recycle!



Increases economic security by tapping a domestic source of materials.

Decreases litter and pollution caused by waste. Less than 22% of discarded waste in the U.S. is recycled.



Americans throw away 2,500,000 plastic water bottles every hour!

Aluminum cans can be recycled an unlimited number of times!



Decreases the need for raw materials so that rainforests can be preserved.



VPPSA ACCEPTABLE ITEMS



- Plastic Bottles & Jugs
- Glass Bottles & Jars
- Cardboard & Mixed Paper
- Metal & Aluminum Cans



Items NOT ACCEPTED in Curbside Recycling

- **Plastic bags:** grocery, dry cleaning, garbage, sandwich bags, plastic wrap
- **Greasy paper:** pizza boxes
- **Wax-covered fiber:** milk cartons & juice boxes, candy wrappers, some packing paper
- **Napkins, paper towels, tissues**
- **Twine, string, wire**
- **Ceramic dishes or ovenware**
- **Light bulbs:** fluorescent and regular
- **Needles or other medical waste**
- **Clothes hangers, lawn chair frames, pots & pans, other scrap metal**
- **Paint & aerosol cans**
- **Any plastic pesticide, poison, automotive product containers**
- **Foam plastic products:** Styrofoam® cups, plates, packing materials
- **Diapers, other personal care products**
- **Yard waste & debris**
- **Plastic bottle caps**
- **Yogurt cups**
- **Clamshell containers:** strawberry & blueberry packaging

- Credit or debit card over the phone- a 2.95% convenience fee will be applied to all card payments
